

## Musical Theatre Section

Please refer to the Provincial regulations concerning entry at the Provincial level.  
 Note: Competitors may enter both Solo and Duet classes. All classes are "Own Choice, One Selection".

### Musical Theatre - Rules & Regulation

It is expected that all competitors in Musical Theatre reflect in their performances the setting, characters and themes of the piece as found in the original stage show. Competitors aged 12 & under have the option of performing a piece from a film. Performances that do not meet these criteria will receive an adjudication only.

Original copies of the music must be provided to the adjudicator, and must be displayed on the piano by the accompanist. Photocopies will result in automatic disqualification.

Accompaniment is restricted to the piano provided at the venue.

Actual performance time of the piece should not exceed seven minutes.

Props must be set up on the stage within three minutes. Exceeding this time limit will result in disqualification. Live props are not permitted on or off stage. Keep props to a minimum.

The intention of the Musical Theatre competition is that the piece be one that can be delivered, as is, by a solo performer, and does not require any specific interaction, scripted or unscripted, between the performer and another animate object (e.g. the audience or another live performer elsewhere) for its staging. Any piece requiring a specific response from another person, or the audience, would be judged as an ensemble piece by the adjudicator, and disqualified from placing in the competition, or from receiving an award. This does not preclude the possibility of a brief, spontaneous and/or unscripted response from the audience, or someone in the audience, as a result of the performer's staging of the piece.

The piano and the accompanist may not be used as props. For example, they cannot be used in any way that requires them to be part of the staging of the piece. Abuse of this expectation will result in disqualification.

A brief, off-stage introduction to the Musical Theater piece is permitted.
